GP17/086 Stone Traders Christmas Market

This was referred from Tourism & Town Promotion Meeting, Minute Number TTP17/006, 19th July 2016. This extra meeting has been called due to the tight time constraints involved.

The Clerk reported that he had been asked to look for ways in which the Council can support the traders with the Christmas Market. Legally the Council cannot provide the marquees free of charge to the traders. However, if the Council run the market themselves under Markets Legislation they would be free to set a zero charge for the use of the marquees. This would cost the Council £225 for the cost of erecting eight double and one single marquee. The organisation of the market could be sub-contracted, provided that all of the Council's normal market requirements are met.

RESOLVED: To arrange a Christmas Market on 7th December 2016, the detailed organisation of which would be sub-contracted to the traders themselves. It was noted that any costs in addition to the £225 for stall erection and £100 for a road closure would be met by the traders direct. The Council's cost of £325 would be met from the Tourism and Town Promotion budget.
