Furthermore, to affix a number of the signs relating to the car park to the wall of the hotel (sign numbers on site plan: 7, 8, 8a and 9)

Amendment – Details of signage including content, size and location. The scheme has not been amended again but the block plan makes the development proposal clearer.

Observations: After discussing the development proposal again, the Town Council wishes to restate its previous objections to the signage and cameras. The observations given in its letter dated 22 May 2019 are:

After considering the amended plans the Town Council does not believe the differences result in any material change to the original development proposal.

The Town Council objects to this planning application for the following reasons:

- The Crown Hotel is a listed building.
- The quantity and size of the signage is inappropriate and intrusive within the conservation area.
- The stated purpose of the signage and ANPR cameras is to 'keep track of who is entering and exiting the car park'. The reasons for wishing to manage traffic flow was questioned and it was suggested that a different method of achieving this aim is identified.

In addition, the Town Council stated that, as the local authority best placed to represent the interests of the people of Stone, it strongly objects to the planning application whatever the colour or size of the signage, as the car park is located within a Conservation Area and the Crown Hotel is a listed building with significant historic heritage.
