



PRESS RELEASE

Remembrance Sunday 10th November 2024

The Annual Parade, together with Services of Remembrance at the War Memorial in Granville Square and later at the Parish Church of St. Michael and St. Wulfad, will take place on Sunday 10th November.

The arrangements are as follows: -

- 10.15 a.m. Parade Personnel to assemble at the bottom of the High Street. Veterans and Members of Ex-Service organisations are welcome to join the parade.
- 10.35 a.m. The parade, led by Stone Scout & Guide Band, will proceed along the High Street to the War Memorial, where Florence Brass Band will play.
- 10.45 a.m. Presentation of Wreaths in accordance with the formal Order of Presentation. People laying wreaths (including any not on the Order of Presentation) should kindly report to Mr I Prescott, the Parade Marshal, during the assembly in the High Street, to be briefed on the wreath laying ceremony.
- 11.00 a.m. Two Minutes Silence and Service of Remembrance.

All those laying wreaths will be asked to walk together in the parade or asked to assemble together prior to the parade reaching the top of the High Street and asked to stand near to the War Memorial in order to streamline the laying of the wreaths.

At the conclusion of the Service at the War Memorial, the Parade will proceed to the Parish Church of St. Michael and St. Wulfad via the High Street and Church Street led by Stone Scout and Guide Band, where the Colour and Standard Bearers are requested to line up at the entrance to the Church, and when instructed enter the Church, present their Colours, and then take the seats reserved for them.

After the Church Service the parade will disband and will not proceed to Market Square.

Earlier in the morning, the customary Service of Remembrance will be held at the Walton War Memorial, Whitmill Lane, Walton, commencing at 9.50 a.m. and individuals and organisations are cordially invited to participate. People attending should kindly assemble at the War Memorial by 9.40 a.m.
